EMERALD HEIGHTS BICYCLE RULES 2022-23

Please take note of the Emerald Heights Bicycle Rules below and the "Rules of the Road," which outline rules for riding on the street and sidewalk. Our bicycle rules are strict because we care about the safety of students. Remember that riding to school is a privilege. Students may lose the privilege of riding a bicycle to school if the rules are not followed.

- 1. Students in Grades 3 4 5 may ride their bikes to Emerald Heights unescorted by a parent but must have signed a bicycle contract to do so. Please complete the attached contract and return it to the school office.
- 2. Students younger than 3rd grade may ride to and from school when accompanied by an adult. They may lock their bike in the bike racks during the school day.
- 3. Bicycle riders MUST wear safety helmets for their own protection. Helmets must fit correctly and be buckled on when riding.
- 4. Bicycles must be walked on sidewalks around the school and inside the school grounds. We have a NO WHEELS rule inside the school grounds, meaning NO bikes, skateboards, scooters or other wheels may be ridden on campus grounds during school hours.
- 5. Bicycles must be parked and locked in the bicycle rack located behind the portables. Emerald Heights is not responsible for lost or stolen items brought to school.
- 6. No motorized bicycles are to be ridden to school. Motorized bicycles are not allowed on the school grounds at any time.
- 7. If at all possible, use the gates at the north and south sides of Emerald Heights to enter and exit the grounds. If entering or exiting on Pinnacle, walk your bike to and from Ridgetop. Do not try to use the stairs. Walk your bike on the sidewalk that runs around the south parking area.

Bicycle Safety "Rules of the Road"

1. Rules for Riding on the Street:

- Always ride on the right hand side (same direction as traffic).
- Obey traffic laws, including all the traffic signs and signals.
- Ride predictably—ride in a straight line, don't weave in and out of traffic.
- Look before turning use hand signals when turning.
- Watch for vehicles going in and out of driveways.
- Keep both hands on the handlebars, except when signaling.
- Always stop and walk your bicycle across the street. Use a crosswalk if available.
 Look left, right, left, and behind you for traffic.
- If entering or exiting on Pinnacle, walk your bike to and from Ridgetop. Do not try to use the stairs. Walk your bike on the sidewalk the runs around the south parking area.

2. Rules for Riding on the Sidewalk:

- When riding on a sidewalk -- Go SLOW!
- Watch for cars coming out of driveways and realize they may not see you.
- Pedestrians always have the right away. Be courteous and show respect for the people walking on the sidewalk.
- If you come up behind people walking, be very polite and wait for a good time to ask them to let you pass.
- If you cannot pass safely, then get off your bike and walk your bike around the pedestrians.
- Always stop and walk your bicycle across the street. Use a crosswalk if available.
 Look left, right, left, and behind you for traffic.
- If entering or exiting on Pinnacle, walk your bike to and from Ridgetop. Do not try to use the stairs. Walk your bike on the sidewalk that runs around the south parking area.

BICYCLE RULES

- 1. 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students may ride a bike without an adult.
- 2. 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students must have a bicycle contract on file with the school office.

 These can be obtained in the front office.
- 3. You must wear a helmet when riding.
- 4. If at all possible, use the gates at the north and south sides of Emerald Heights to enter and exit the grounds. If you must enter or exit on Pinnacle, walk your bike to and from Ridgetop. Do not try to use the stairs. Walk your bike on the sidewalk that runs around the south parking area.
- 4. Once you are on campus, you must walk your bike
- 5. Riding bikes before or after school is not allowed...wait until after 4pm and on weekends.
- 6. Bikes must be parked in the bicycle rack and locked.
- 7. The school assumes no responsibility for lost or damaged items.
